HARLAY AVOCATS COUNSELS EVA IN THE CONTEXT OF A 5-MILLION FUNDRAISING

EVA (ex-SmartVR Studio), French startup leader in virtual reality esports, raises €5 million to support the opening of its franchise network in the US.

Created in 2018 by Jean Mariotte, Stéphanie Belle and William Klein, EVA (Esports Virtual Arenas) combines VR esport and physical effort through After-H, a video game in hyper free roaming technology, which allows players equipped with VR helmets and connected backpacks and guns to compete on 500m² areas.

EVA accompanies the launch, in France, of gaming rooms offering competitive matches during which two teams of four people face each other in virtual reality.

Around thirty establishments should be created before the end of the year and EVA plans on opening about 100 facilities by 2025.

This fundraising, to which Bpi and Business Angels, including Alexandre Yazdi (Voodoo) and Jean-Baptiste Rudelle (Criteo), participated, will allow the publisher to deploy its network in the United States and to strenghthen its offer through the recruitment of new profiles.
